

PARROT SOCIETY RING SCHEME

Ringing birds has a number of advantages. If they escape and are found it is easy to prove that you are the owner of the bird. As closed rings have the year on them when birds are bred you know how old they are. When birds are sold at our shows the ring details assist in tracing birds and can be recorded on the show schedule forms. Rings also prove their worth when updating breeding records and maintaining accurate studbooks. By close ringing a bird it is proof that it has been bred in captivity and not obtained from the wild.

In the future the PS Council would like to see many more close rung birds at our events. Our approved ring supplier is Jim Reeves of Avian ID. A ring order form is included in every January magazine.

The numerics in brackets below the ring are the internal diameter of the ring in millimetres.
